Dear Property Owner:

Florida Statute 196.202 reads in part...

“property to the value of \$5,000 of every blind person, or totally and permanently disabled person who is a bona fide resident of this state shall be exempt from taxation.”

If you are disabled, you may be eligible for a \$5,000 Disabled person's exemption. In order to receive the exemption for the upcoming Tax Year, you must have a "Physician's Certification of Total and Permanent Disability" (DR-416) completed by a licensed Florida physician or a letter from the Social Security Administration indicating the date you became disabled. A letter from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs may also be acceptable if treated by the VA.

If you are currently receiving a Homestead exemption, please complete the required information on the bottom of this form including your signature and the date. Attach and mail your proof of disability documentation to one of our offices listed above **prior to March 1** of the year filing. Information submitted after March 1 will be considered for the following Tax Year.
